Internship Application Requirements

- 1. A letter of purpose or intention (this should include the reasons you are interested in the position, your goals, and your ambitions).**
- 2. A detailed CV or resume.**
- 3. Three recommendation letters that discuss both professional qualifications and personal character.**
- 4. Two pictures in .jpg format (in order to pair up the name with a face).**

Candidates should familiarize themselves with the American Farm School and its mission, and learn details about the Secondary School and Perrotis College, by visiting the website, www.afs.edu.gr.

Additional Information:

- It is essential that interns understand that most first-year AFS students have little background in the English language, but by the time they graduate they communicate with adequate English skills. Interns should be equipped with techniques to break the language barrier (games, strategies to motivate the students in participating in extra-curricular activities, etc.).
- Although classes in the Secondary School are taught in Greek, the administration and faculty place great emphasis on learning the English language. The contribution of Secondary School interns is vital to encouraging and reinforcing the development of English language skills.
- The student body of Perrotis College is international. Although English is the language of instruction, individual students have different levels of English proficiency. Therefore, encouraging and reinforcing students' English language skills is an important responsibility for interns in Perrotis College as well.
- Interns live in single rooms with private baths in the Secondary School or Perrotis College dormitories.
- Interns are role models for the Secondary School and Perrotis College students. As such, they expected not to smoke cigarettes, or engage in other behavior that may negatively influence the students, while performing their internship duties.

Candidates are asked to submit their applications in a timely manner. Interviews will be scheduled after completed applications have been received.
